LALIVE Secures US\$330 million arbitration award for GreenX

The firm is proud to have secured a US\$330 million victory for subsidiaries of GreenX Metals Ltd (previously known as Prairie Mining) in international arbitration proceedings against the Republic of Poland under both the Australia-Poland bilateral investment treaty and the Energy Charter Treaty.
